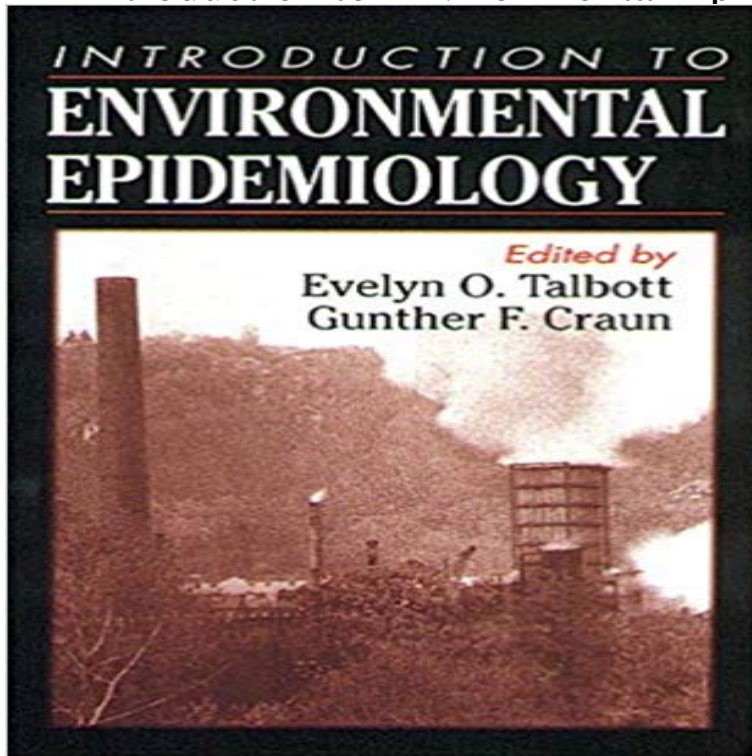


An Introduction to Environmental Epidemiology
