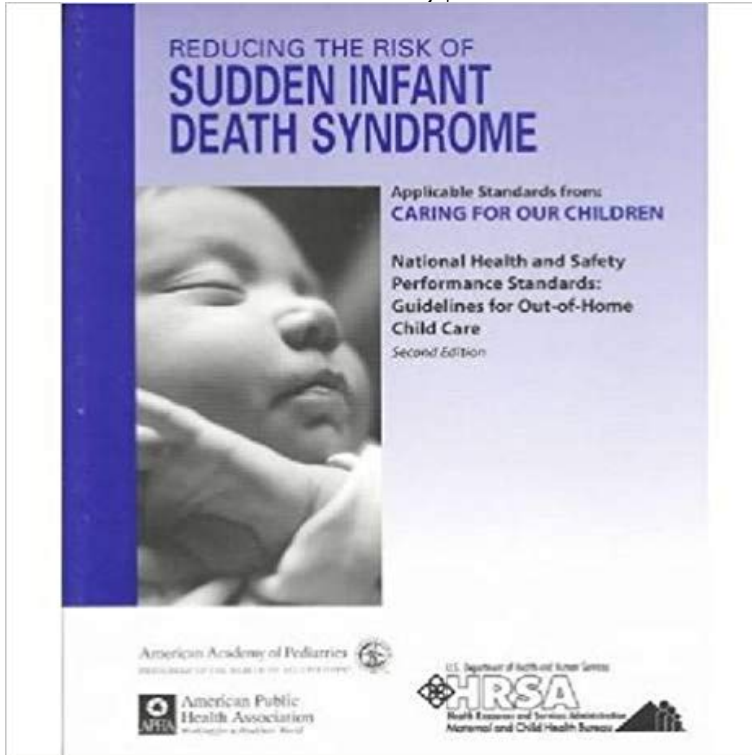


Reducing the Risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome: Applicable Standards from Caring for Our Children
