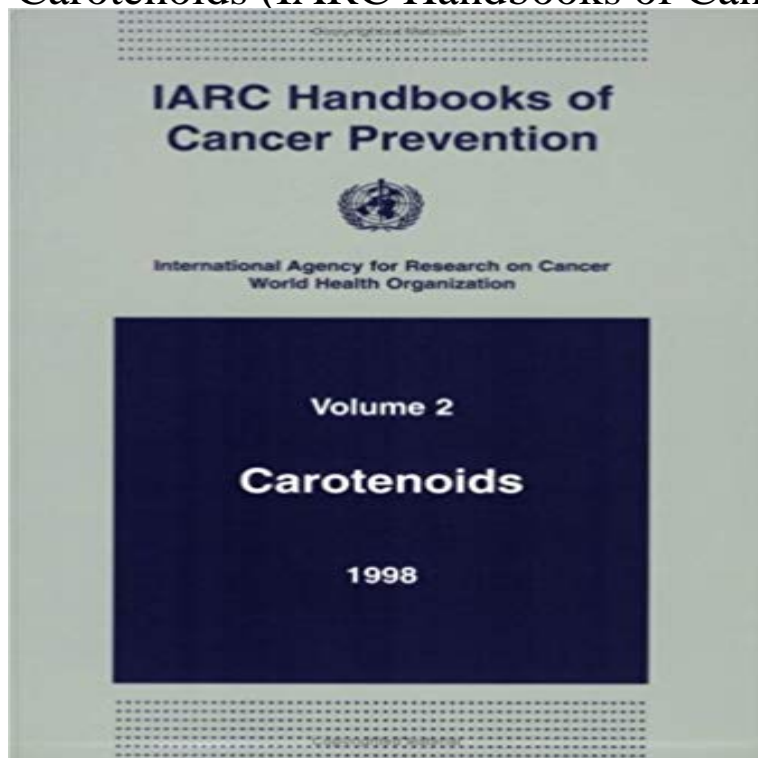


Carotenoids (IARC Handbooks of Cancer Prevention)

A summary of data and recommendations for research are provided at the end.
