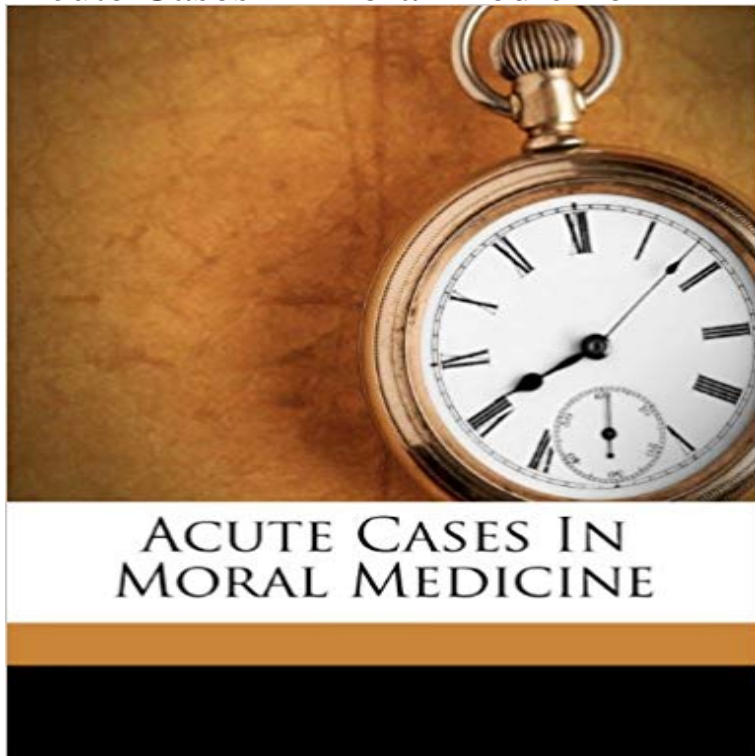


## Acute Cases In Moral Medicine
