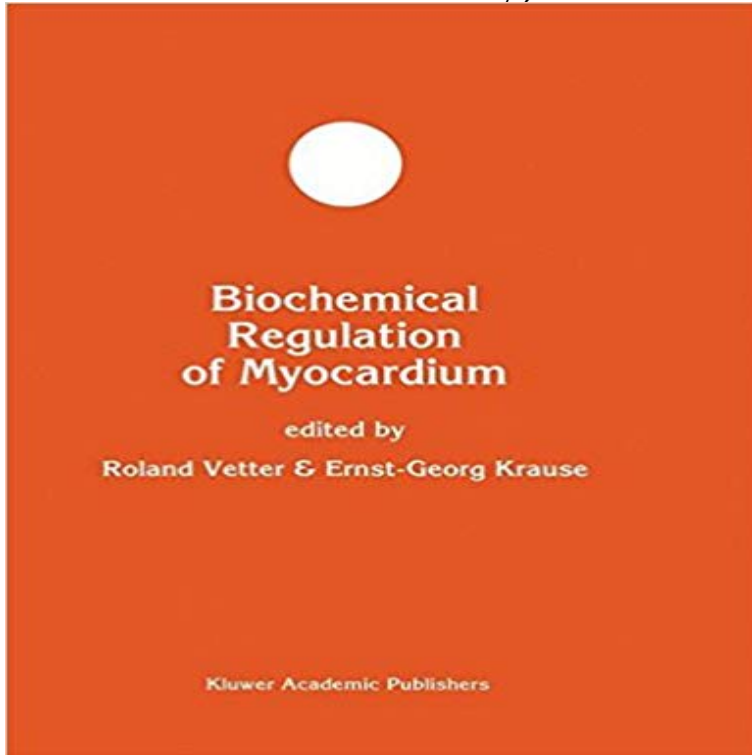


Biochemical Regulation of Myocardium (Developments in Molecular and Cellular Biochemistry)
