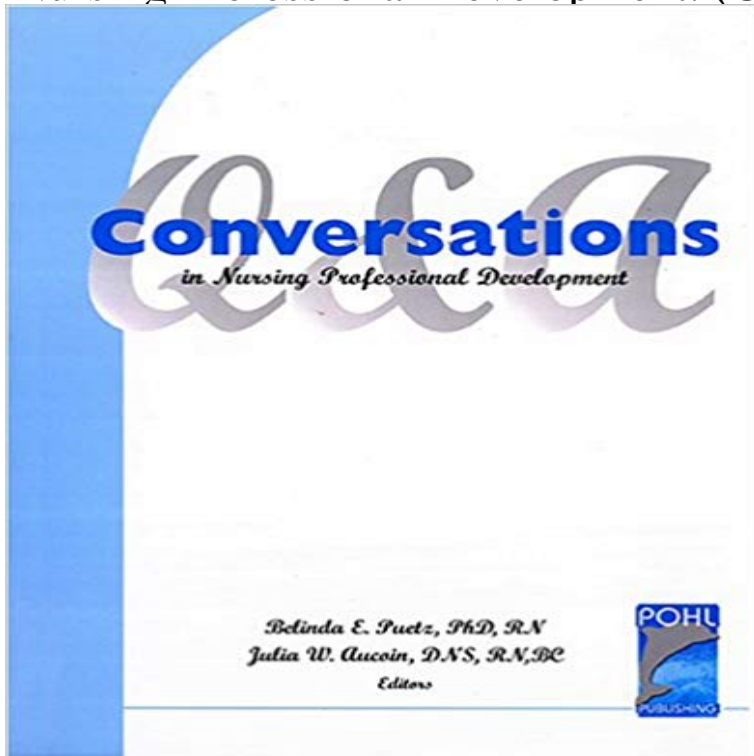


## Nursing Professional Development: (Conversations in S)
