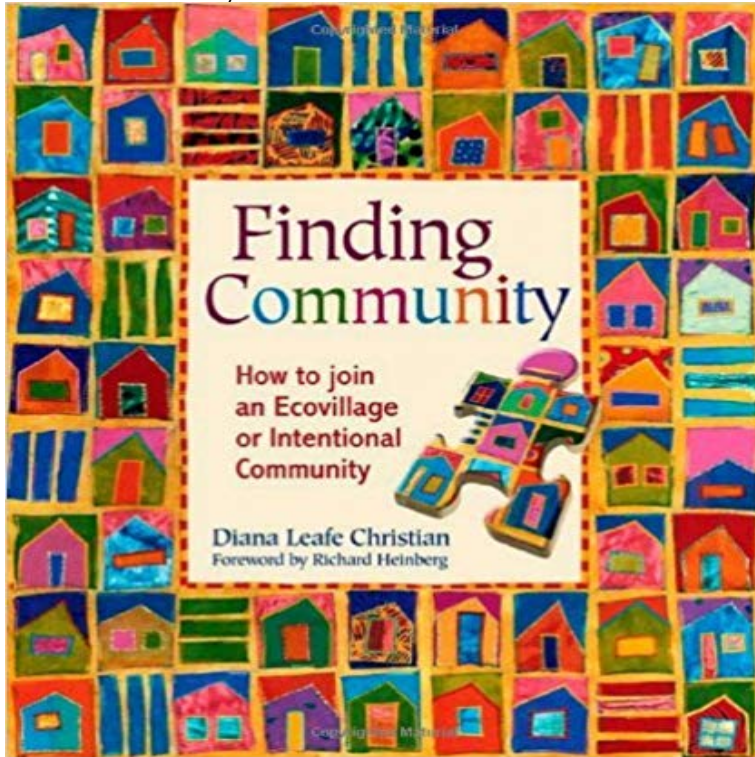


# Finding Community: How to Join an Ecovillage or Intentional Community

These intentional communities or ecovillages are an appealing choice for like-minded people who seek to create a family-oriented and ecologically sustainable lifestyle. However, the notion of an intentional community can still be a tremendous leap for some, perhaps by a misguided vision of eking out a hard-scrabble existence with little reward. In fact, successful ecovillages thrive because of the combined skills and resources of their members.
