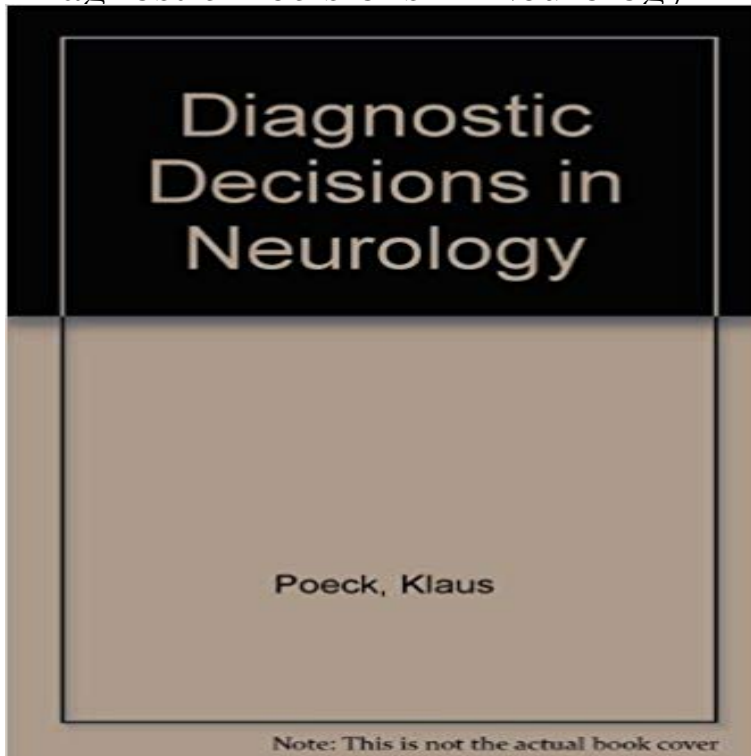


Diagnostic Decisions in Neurology
