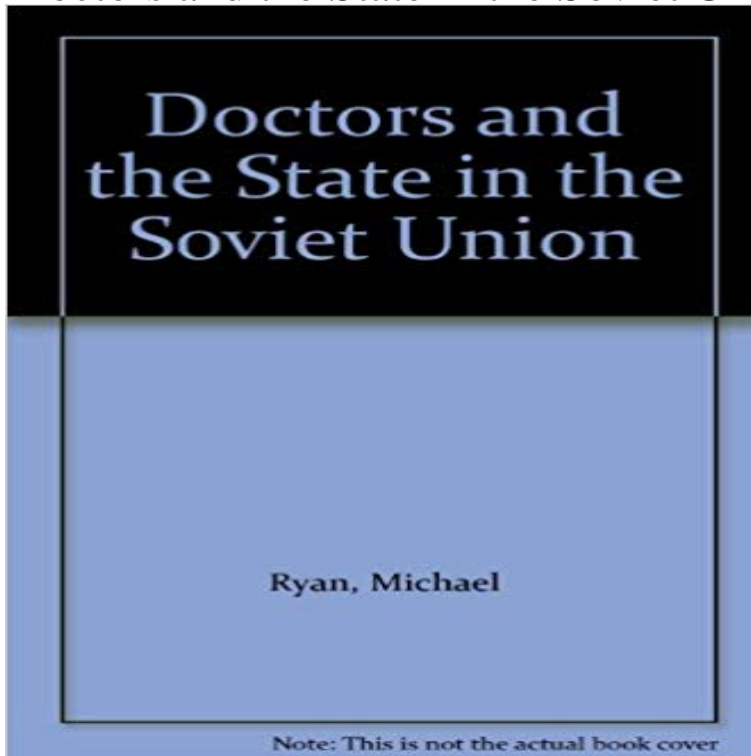


Doctors and the State in the Soviet Union
