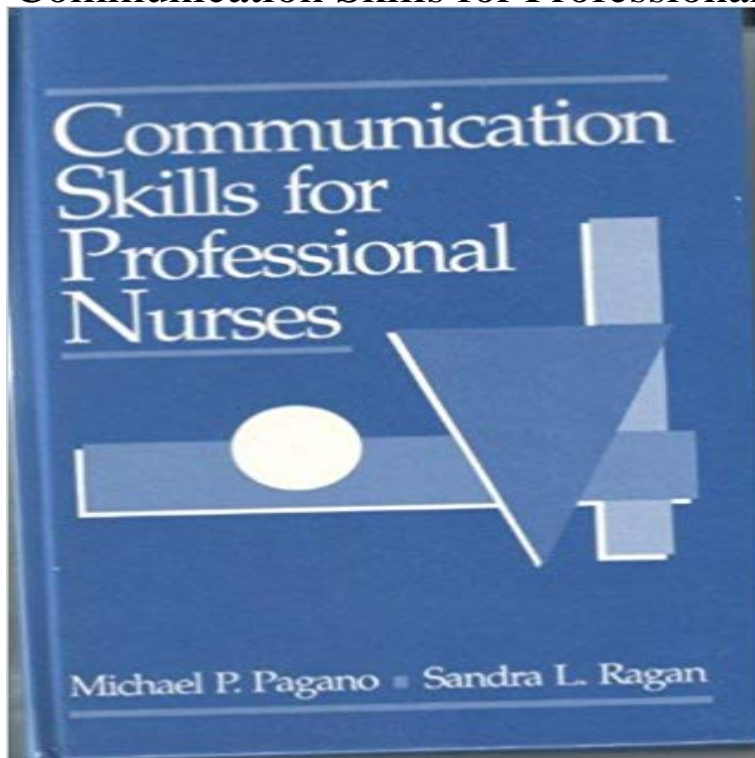


Communication Skills for Professional Nurses
