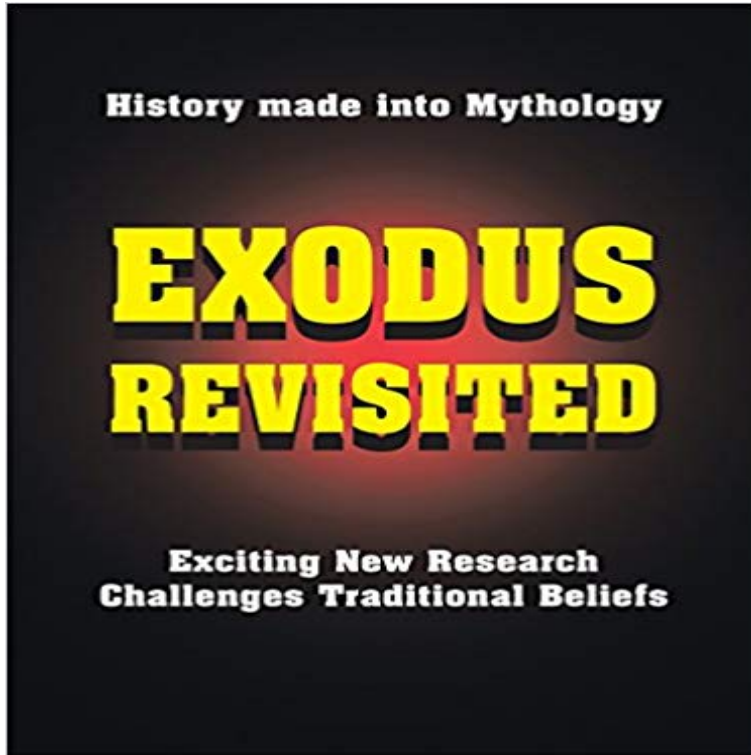


EXODUS REVISITED: Exciting New Research Challenges Traditional Beliefs
