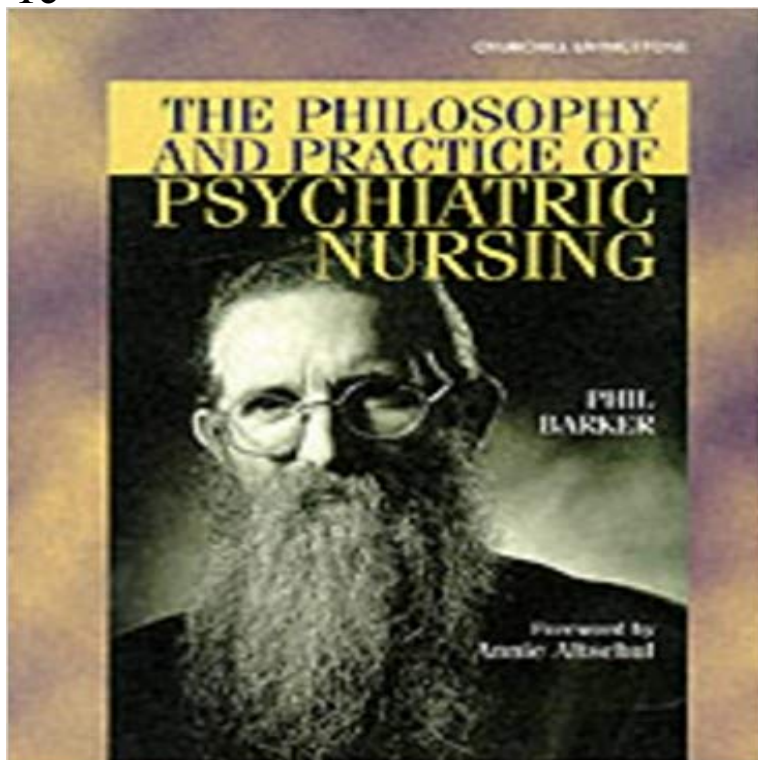


The Philosophy and Practice of Psychiatric Nursing: Selected Writings, 1e
