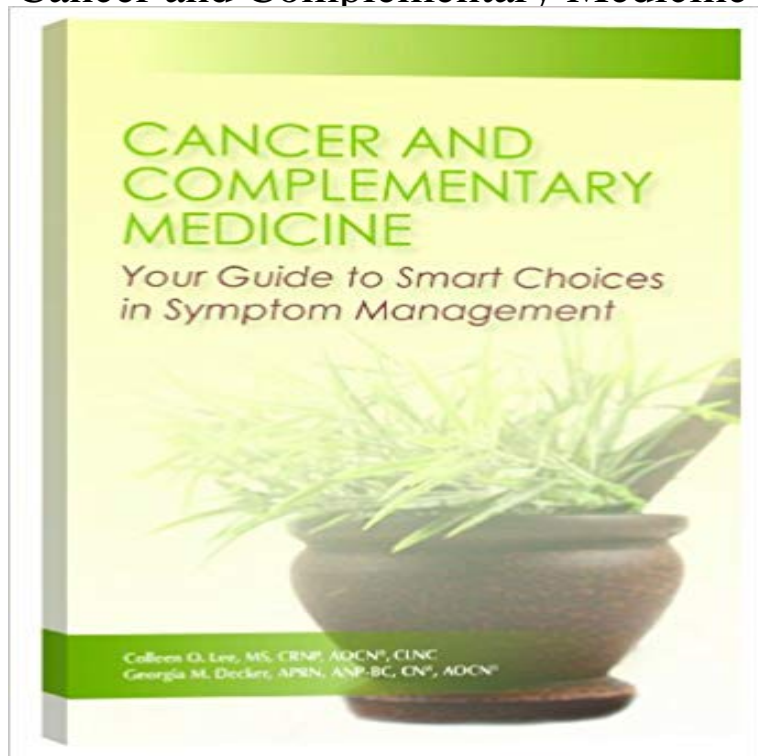


Cancer and Complementary Medicine
