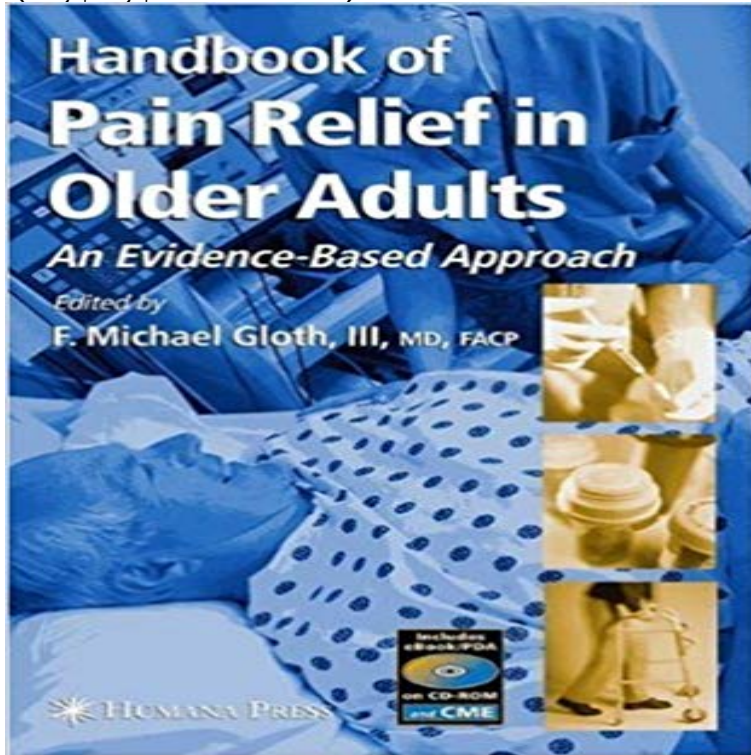


Handbook of Pain Relief in Older Adults: An Evidence-Based Approach (Aging Medicine)
