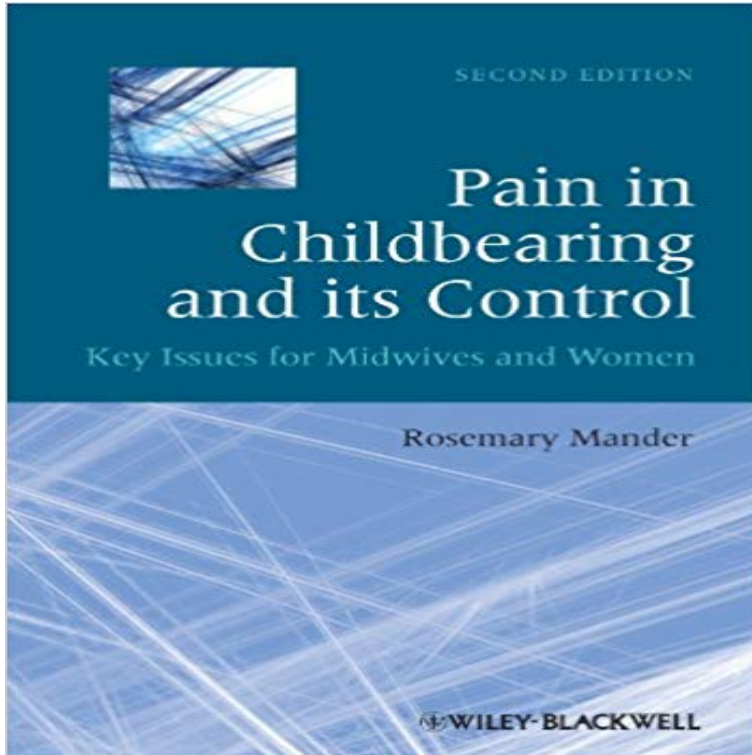


Pain in Childbearing and its Control: Key Issues for Midwives and Women
