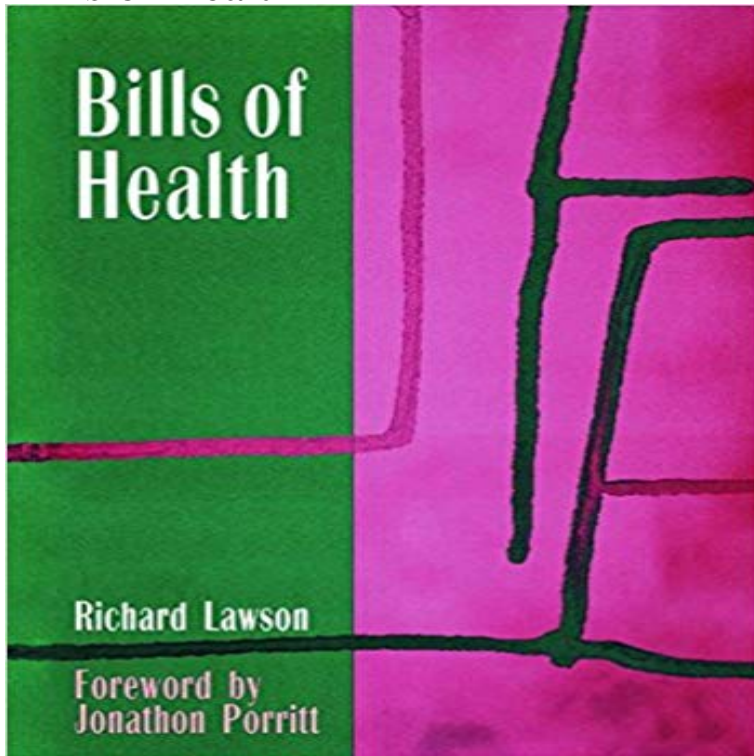


Bills of Health
