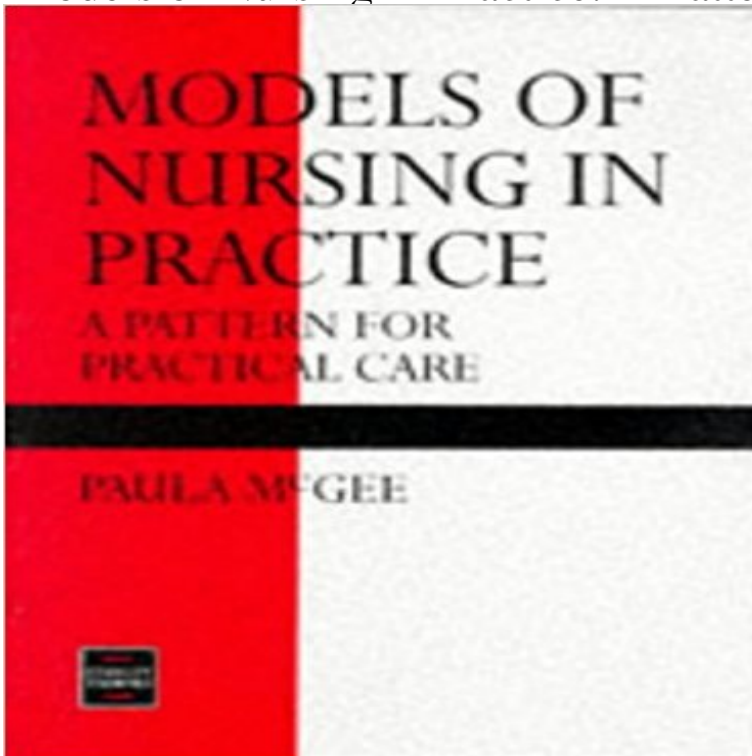


## Models of Nursing in Practice: A Pattern for Practical Care
