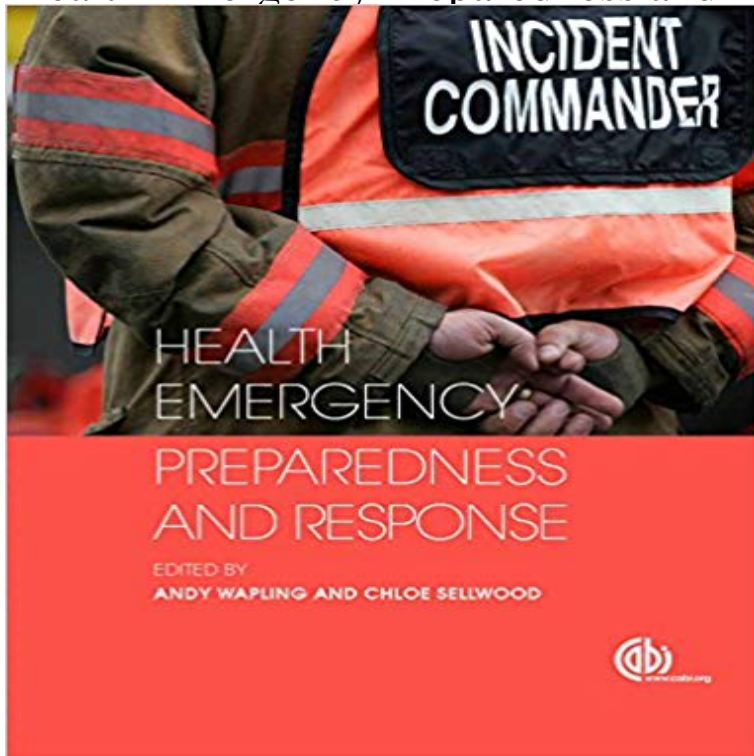


Health Emergency Preparedness and Response
