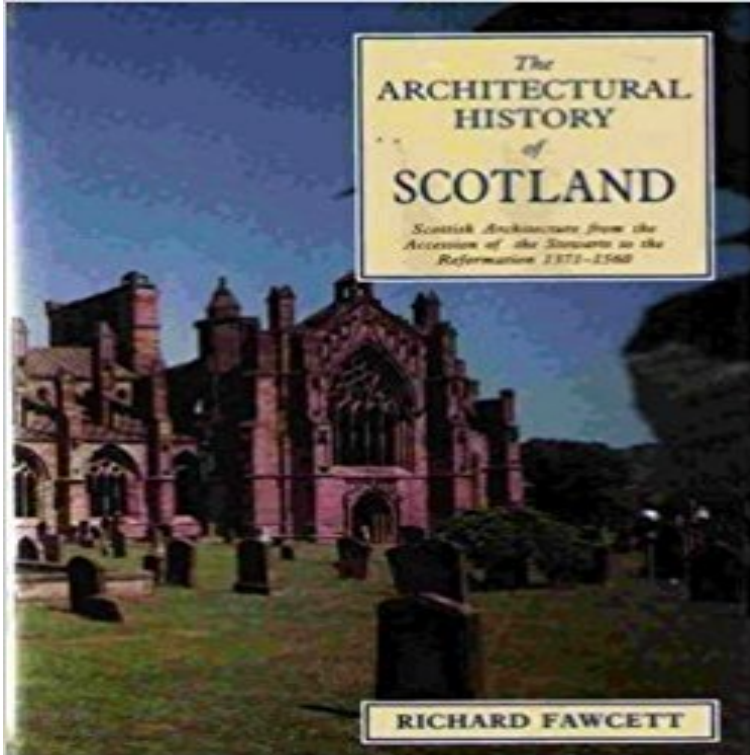


## Scottish Architecture: From the Accession of the Stewarts to the Reformation, 1371-1560 (Architectural History of Scotland)
