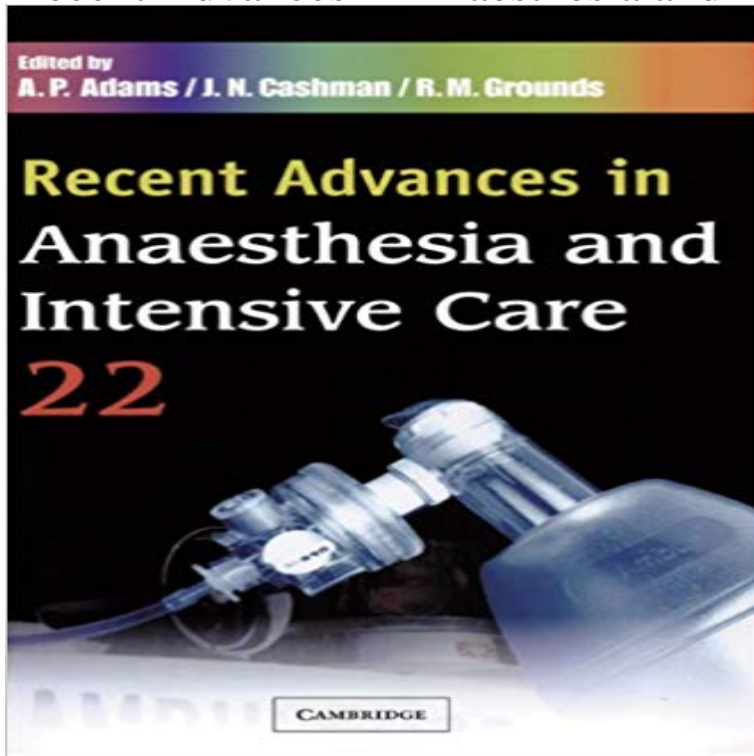


Recent Advances in Anaesthesia and Intensive Care: Volume 22
