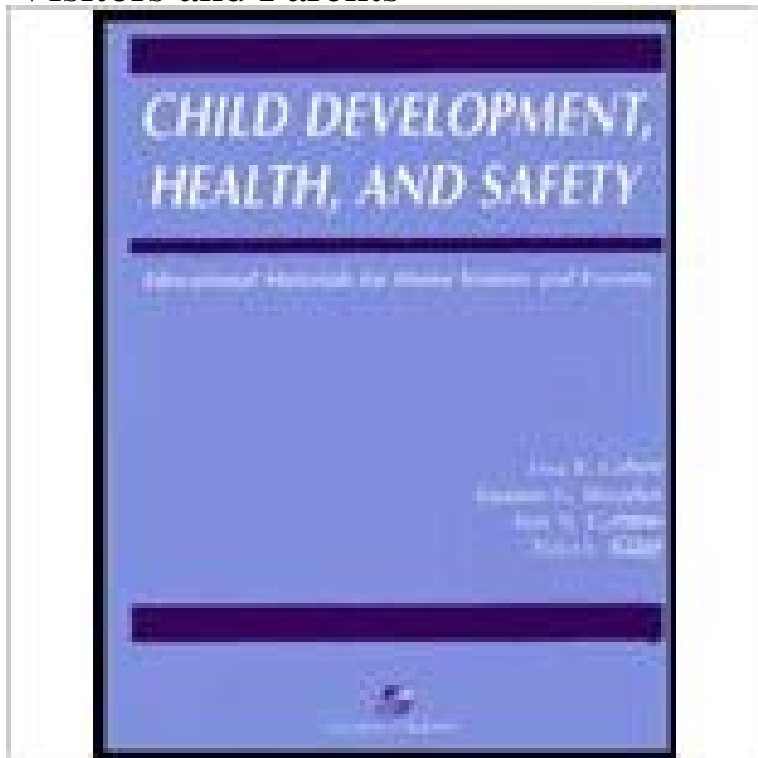


# Child Development, Health, and Safety: Educational Materials for Home Visitors and Parents
