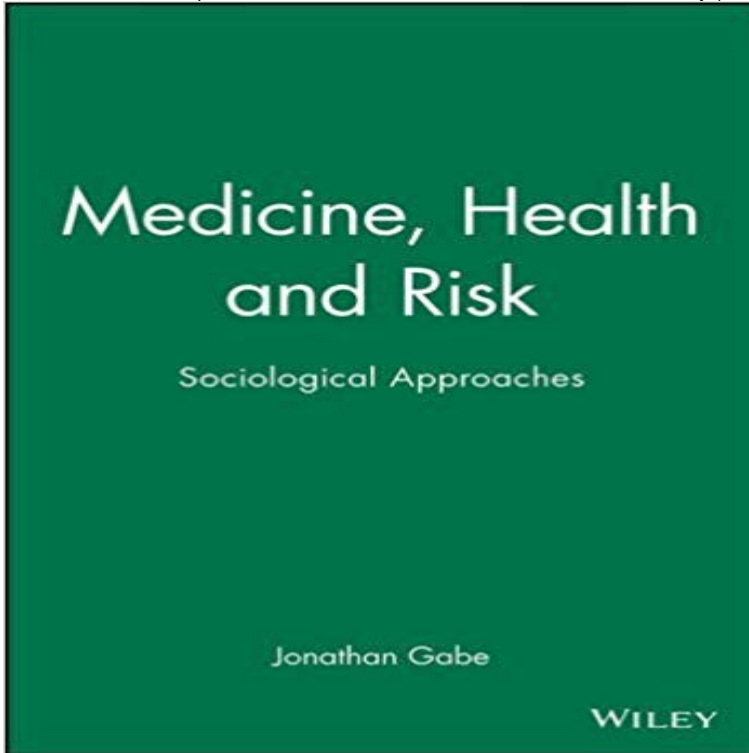


# Medicine, Health and Risk: Sociological Approaches
