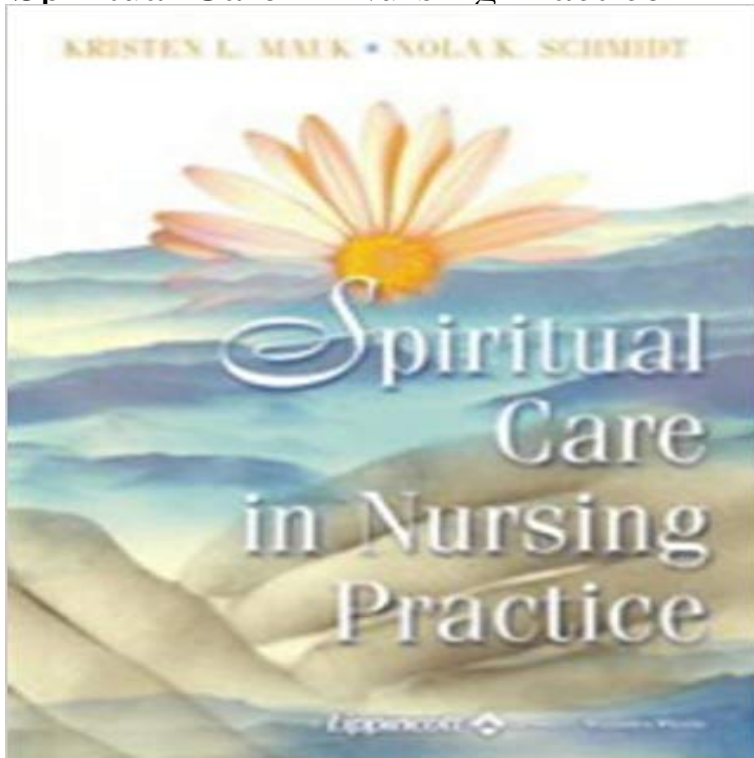


Spiritual Care in Nursing Practice
