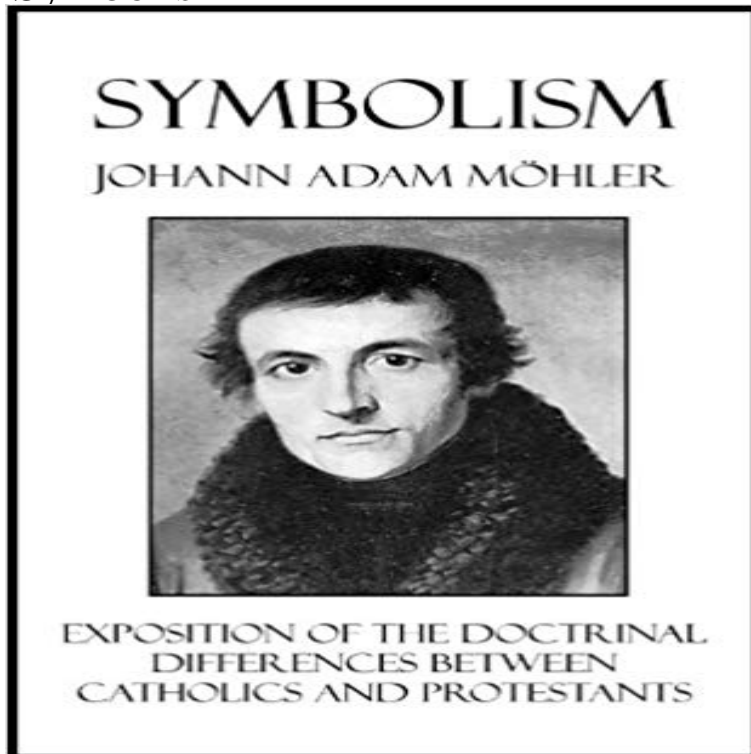


Symbolism



Or, Exposition of the Doctrinal Differences between Catholics and Protestants, as evidenced by their Symbolical Writings Complete in two volumes, this is the 1843 English edition. Hailed in 1987 by then Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger as the great reviver of Catholic theology after the ravages of the Enlightenment, Mohler had a significant influence on the development of Catholic theology in the twentieth century, inspiring theologians such as Karl Rahner and Yves Congar. Symbolism is Mohler's greatest accomplishment, in which he develops and sheds light on the main issues in theological anthropology and ecclesiology within the context of a critical dialogue with Protestant theology. After studying philosophy and theology in the lyceum at Ellwangen, Mohler entered the University of Tübingen in 1817. Ordained to the priesthood in 1819, he was appointed to a curacy. He returned to Tübingen where he became privatdozent in 1825, extraordinary professor of theology in 1826 and ordinary professor in 1828. His lectures drew large audiences, including many Protestants. The controversy aroused by this book in 1832 was such that in 1835 he left for the University of Munich, because of polemics with the Protestant Tübingen theologian Ferdinand Christian Baur. In 1838 he was appointed to the deanery of Würzburg, but died shortly afterwards.
