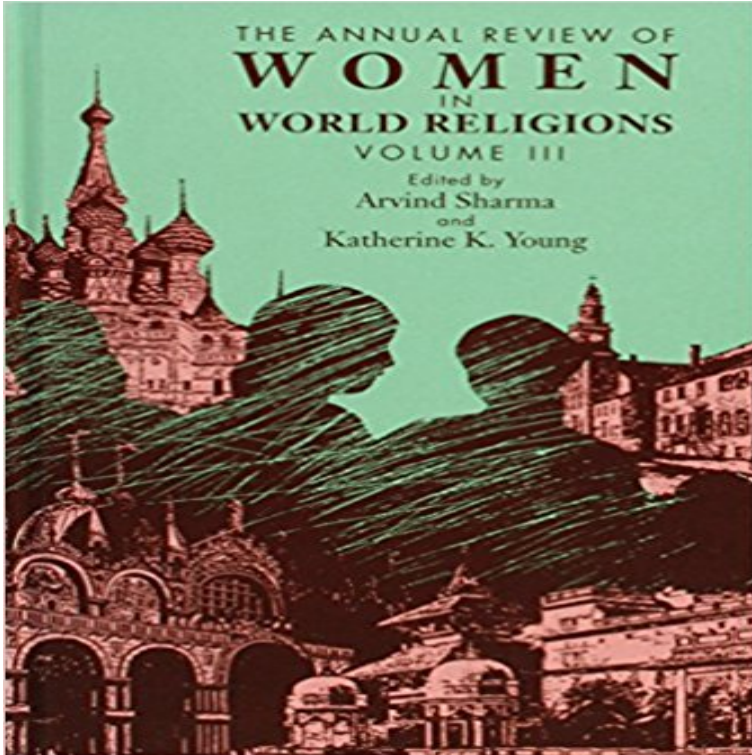


Annual Review of Women in World Religions: Volume III
