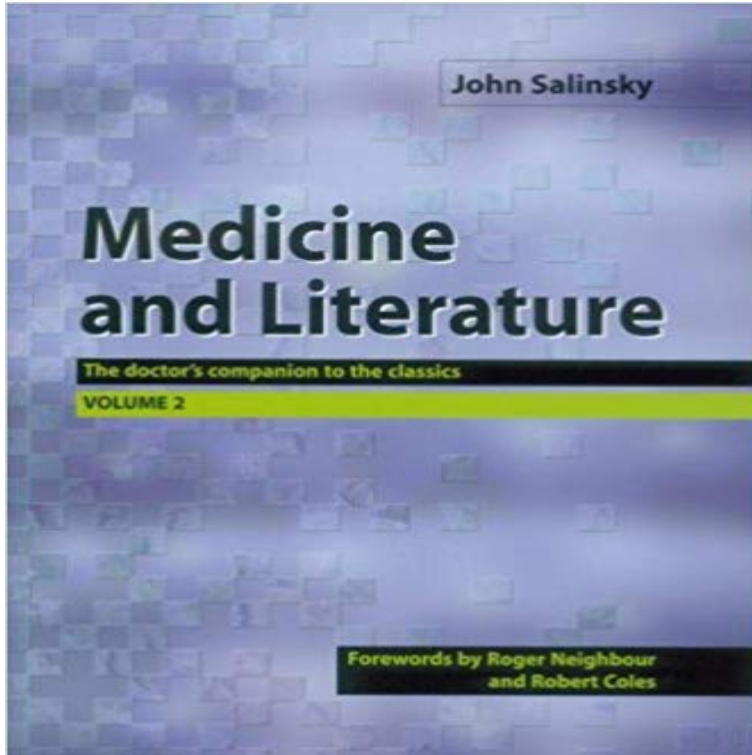


Medicine and Literature, Volume Two: The Doctors Companion to the Classics
