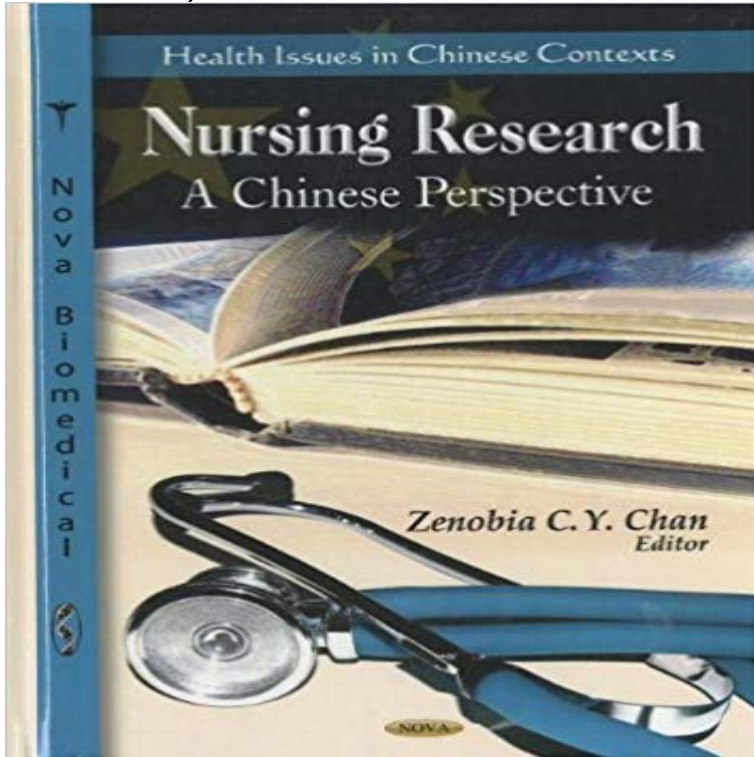


# Nursing Research: A Chinese Perspective (Health Issues in Chinese Contexts)
