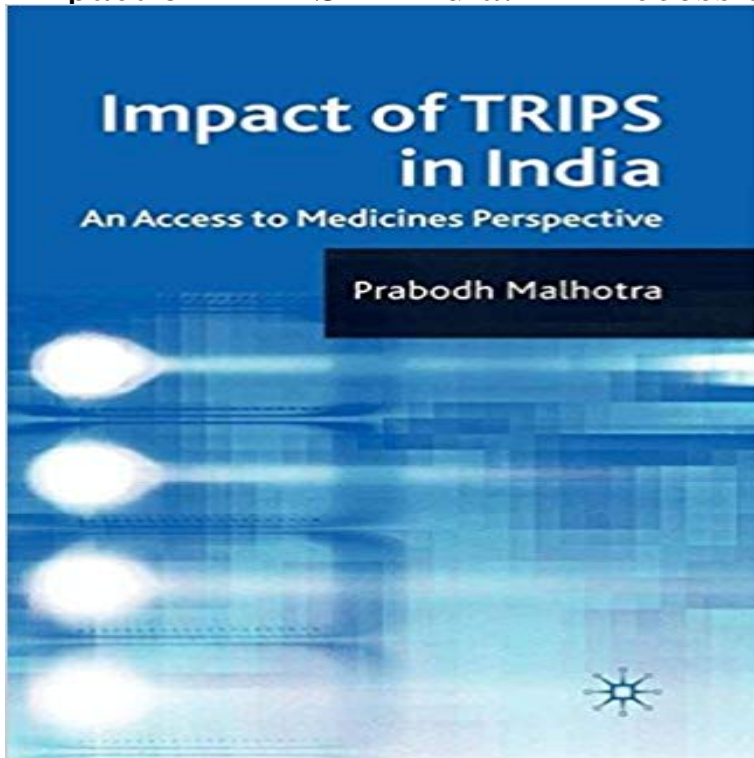


Impact of TRIPS in India: An Access to Medicines Perspective
